The Hancock County Board of Education met in special session on Tuesday, May 18, 2004, in the Board Room, New Cumberland, commencing at 5:30 p.m. Board Members present: Joe Barnabei, John Manypenny, Ronald Daugherty, and Chris Fair, and Craig Andrews, President.

The purpose of this meeting: Work Session/Business

The Board viewed a presentation of the AESOP substitute callout system presented by a representative of AESOP. The presentation was made via the internet and a speakerphone. Mr. Casini coordinated the presentation.

The Board of Education reviewed coaching policy GCA and made several recommendations for change. The policy will be brought back to the Board of Education for a 3rd first reading during the May 24, 2004 meeting.
